Jazz Camp for Girls

WHAT IS JAZZ CAMP FOR GIRLS

Jazz Camp for Girls is a 3-day music summer camp for girls aged 11-15 to explore jazz music and improvisation in a supportive and fun environment that also celebrates the role of women working in jazz music.

WHO IS IT FOR

The camp is for girls aged 11-15 with at least 1 year experience learning a musical instrument (but it does not need to be a traditional jazz instrument) and an interest in exploring and experimenting with this more in a group setting.

WHEN IS IT

Jazz Camp will take place from Tuesday 27th to Thursday 29th June 2023 from 10am to 4pm daily (with a supervised break for lunch).

WHERE WILL IT TAKE PLACE?

The Camp will take place in DCU St Patrick's campus (B Block) in Drumcondra in the rehearsal rooms and classrooms used by the Jazz Degree programme during term time. The 3rd level students will be on holiday, so we will have full access to the college facilities for the Jazz Camp!

WHAT HAPPENS AT JAZZ CAMP

The programme at Jazz Camp is all about learning and exploring together in a fun environment. The students can expect games and practices exploring rhythms, scale work and the basis of jazz theory - for example learning blues songs and using pentatonic (5 note) blues scales to improvise with.

You will also explore how jazz influences other types of music (such as pop music), play music solo and playing together in bands, and learn about the power of improvisation as a tool to develop your skills as a player, and help you to write your own tunes. In general simple and effective tools to help with playing jazz and improvised music!

HOW MUCH IS IT

The cost is €30 for the 3 day camp. Some scholarships are available for those who need additional support. If you would like to be considered for this, please email aoife@improvisedmusic.ie

We will chat to you in advance about your instrument, but yes if it is possible, please do bring your instrument. However if you play piano or drums for example, you can use the instruments that will be available in the college.
